## NOTICE OF QUARANTINE

By authority conferred upon the Director of the Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development by the Animal Industry Act, Public Act 466 of 1988, as amended, MCL 287.712, a quarantine is hereby issued to cover the entirety of the State of Michigan to prevent the potential spread of avian influenza.

Effective today, June 1, 2015, all exhibitions or expositions of poultry are prohibited until further notice. As defined in the Animal Industry Act, "poultry" means, but is not limited to, chickens, guinea fowl, turkeys, waterfowl, pigeons, doves, peafowl, and game birds that are propagated and maintained under the husbandry of humans (MCL 287.706(9)).

This quarantine does not extend to permanent poultry exhibits in venues such as zoos.
